

INSTALLATION MANUAL

Thank you so much for purchasing presets from me! It helps me continue to be a full time musician and you to get rocking faster!

Here is a quick tutorial on how to install your brand new Presets.

Step 1:

Open Finder

Step 2:

In your toolbar at the top of your Mac click 'Finder' > Preferences > Sidebar

Step 3:

Select your Home icon to show in the sidebar. For example, mine says 'nicksmacmini'

Step 4:

Exit out of the preferences panel

The next steps depend on the type of product you purchased.

Step 1:

Open your compressed zip file downloaded from nickanderson.online

Step 2:

look at the file extension type. Use the corresponding directions below.

.cst file

Step 1:

Open Finder

Step 2:

Click your 'home' icon that was setup above

Step 3:

Click Folder titled 'Music' > 'Audio Music Apps' > 'Channel Strip Settings' > 'Track'

Step 4:

Drag your new .cst file into the 'Track' folder you just found

Step 5:

Open Logic

Step 6:

Create a new audio track

Step 7:

Open Library in Logic Pro X > User Channel Strip Settings

Your new Preset will show up here.

.pst file

Step 1:

Open Finder

Step 2:

Click your 'home' icon that was setup above

Step 3:

Click Folder titled 'Music' > 'Audio Music Apps' > 'Plug-In Settings' > 'AmpDesigner' (or whatever plugin this preset is for)

Step 4:

Drag your new .pst file into the 'Plugin' folder you just found

Step 5:

Open Logic

Step 6:

Put That Plugin on a Track and Open Up It's Settings

Step 7:

Click the top left drop down menu where you can select other presets.
Your new Preset will show up here.

.patch file

Step 1:

Open Finder

Step 2:

Click your 'home' icon that was setup above

For Real Instruments go to Step 3a. For Virtual Instruments go to Step 3b.

Step 3a for REAL Instruments:

Click Folder titled 'Music' > 'Audio Music Apps' > 'Patches' > 'Audio'

Step 3b for Virtual Instruments

Click Folder titled 'Music' > 'Audio Music Apps' > 'Patches' > 'Instrument'

Step 4:

Drag your new .patch file into the corresponding folder from step 3

Step 5:

Open Logic

Step 6:

Create a new audio track

Step 7:

Open Library in Logic Pro X > User Patches

Your new Preset will show up here.

Project Template file (Kind: Logic Pro Project)

Step 1:

Open Finder

Step 2:

Click your 'home' icon that was setup above

Step 3:

Click Folder titled 'Music' > 'Audio Music Apps' > 'Project Templates'

Step 4:

Drag your new Logic Pro Project file into the 'Project Templates' folder you just found

Step 5:

Open Logic > File > New From Template > My Templates

Step 6:

Select your new template.
